Zero Tolerance Policy

San Francisco Trip 2011

There will be a zero tolerance/no mercy policy concerning inappropriate behavior from the minute we leave Sherwood, OR, Thursday March 31st, until we return Sunday, April 3rd. Regardless of age, school policy and school rules apply 24 hours a day for the entire trip.

ABIDE BY ALL RULES If you break any of the school and trip rules, you will be flown home at your parent's expense. There will not be **any** exceptions. We do not care if you're the best musician. To ensure the safety of all students, we reserve the right and will check all bags before and during the trip if needed. If you have illegal substances, we will leave you at the closest police department to wait for your parents to retrieve you.

1. **NO TOBACCO. NO DRUGS. NO ALCOHOL. NO PDA.** This is not the kind of reputation we want for our band/choir trips. We are about honor and pride.
2. **BE RESPECTFUL** Inappropriate actions or language towards any band member, chaperone or trip host will not be tolerated. All students will abide by the advice, judgment and directions of the adult chaperones
3. **HAVE A POSITIVE ATTITUDE** If you are having a bad day, think of the students who are sitting in math class and not experiencing this event. It will make you feel better.
4. **RESPECT AMMENITIES** Keep your room and bus neat. Do not wrestle, throw things, or jump on beds. Clean up after yourself. Any damage you do to the room or others' property will become your **own financial responsibility**.
5. Only students assigned to the room will be allowed in that room. There are other areas in the hotel where you can visit with other students. There is never a reason why a male should be in a female's room, or a female in a male's room. **Do not** ask a chaperone to bend this rule for you. No student is to leave his or her room after bed check in the evening.
6. **BE GOOD STEWARDS** Include anyone who is alone. Make friends. Never leave anywhere without several friends and a chaperone. You must always check in with your chaperone. Keep track of fellow students. Follow the schedule we will give you!

We have by no means listed everything we may encounter. These rules are to protect and allow us to all have a fun time. We want choir and band trips to continue. We do know you are wonderful students, or we would not be taking you for such an adventure!

TENTATIVE PACKING LIST (as of 02/28/11)

Instrument and Music – Be sure you have your name on your instrument case

- Instrument supplies – mouthpiece, reeds, cork grease, slide grease, valve oil, etc.

Performance Attire –

- Wind Ensemble turn in prior to trip! They will be packed in our garment bags

Dinner Attire

- Casual clothing – shirts, shorts, and pants (school dress code applies)
- Formal (one nights) Saturday Banquet
 - Female – Dressy “Sunday” dress or semi-formal dress and shoes
 - Male – Dress pants, collared shirt (long or short sleeve dress shirt), tie, belt, dress socks, dress shoes and optional, but recommended, jacket

San Fran temperature in late March – High in the low 60's, Low in the mid 40's

- Comfortable walking shoes or athletic shoes and socks
- Sweatshirt or jacket
- Rain jacket, poncho, or travel umbrella – “throw away” ponchos are good!
- Cell phone charger if you plan to bring a cell phone

Luggage/Carry-on bag (backpack) – You will not see your luggage until we arrive in San Fran.

ABSOLUTELY NO FLAMABLE/ACCELERANTS/AEROSOLS ITEMS!!!

- Spending money –souvenirs and snacks
- Medication – prescription and non-prescription medication, eye glasses, contact lens Solution.If you are prone to motion sickness (bus) bring Bonine or Dramamine.
PLEASE CONTACT MR. PETRIK IF YOUR STUDENT HAS MEDICAL CONCERNS THAT WILL NEED ADULT ASSISTANCE*
- Photo ID – driver’s license or learner’s permit and/or school ID
- Toiletries- be sure they are all in zip-lock containers/bags – toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, deodorant, hairbrush, comb, etc
- Change of clothes
- Swimsuit, cover up, pool shoes
- Camera – batteries, memory card, charger, film
- Small pillow and blanket for the bus ride

- Radio, CD player, portable DVD player, iPod, video games – headphones required
- Extra batteries or charger
