- 3. Drum Majors will need to be present at all rehearsals, workshops, and camp dates.
- 4. Drum Majors will need to be very visible around the band room in the summer and fall, helping out with organization, communication, and lending a hand to someone who needs it.
- 5. Need to help oversee weekly sectionals and assist when asked.
- 6. Need to assist with field crew, music room crew, music library, and any other tasks the leadership team takes on.
- 7. Need to be: punctual, well prepared, & organized.
- 8. Need to establish leadership team goals and a realistic plan to achieve those goals.
- 9. Optional: See if there is a period in the day where all Drum Majors can TA for Mr. Stai during the same period (Ideally Period 5 or Period 4).
