• Woodwinds

- 1. Scales Packet: Play Full Range Chromatic Scale. Tempo is quarter = 140 or faster.
- 2. Scales Packet: Play All 12 Major Scales. One or Two octaves optional. Tempo is quarter = 140 or faster.
- 3. Concerto No. 1, Op. 73, Weber
 - Measures 63-98 (play written tempo marking)
- 4. Romanza, Op. 94, No. 1, Schumann
 - Measures 2-30 (play written tempo marking)
- 5. For Students who were not enrolled in an SHS Band Class in 2024-2025, choose one of the following:
 - Play an excerpt of your solo piece from Solo & Ensemble
 - Play an excerpt of something you are working on in private lessons.

Brass

- 1. Scales Packet: Play Full Range Chromatic Scale. Tempo is guarter = 140 or faster.
- 2. Scales Packet: Play All 12 Major Scales. One or Two octaves optional. Tempo is quarter = 140 or faster.
- 3. Allegro from Trumpet Concert in E-flat Major, Hummel
 - a. Start at Pickup to measure 7 measure 42 (play written tempo marking)
- 4. Arioso from Cantata No. 156, Bach
 - b. Measures 5 17 (play written tempo marking)
- 5. For Students who were not enrolled in an SHS Band Class in 2024-2025, choose one of the following:
 - 1. Play an excerpt of your solo piece from Solo & Ensemble
 - 2. Play an excerpt of something you are working on in private lessons.

Percussionists

- 1. Scales Packet: Play All 12 Major Scales. One or Two octaves optional. Tempo is quarter = 140 or faster.
- 2. Percussion Audition
 - Timpani Some of this, Some of that, Hagedorn
 - Measures 22-38 (downbeat; play written tempo marking)
 - Snare Same Words, Different Translation, Hagedorn
 - Measures 1-14 (play written tempo marking)
 - Mallet Concerto No. 1, Op. 73, Weber
 - Measures 63-98 (play written tempo marking)
- 3. For Students who were not enrolled in an SHS Band Class in 2024-2025, choose one of the following:
 - Play an excerpt of your solo piece from Solo & Ensemble
 - Play an excerpt of something you are working on in private lessons.

Piano

- 1. Scales Packet: Play Full Range Chromatic Scale. Tempo is quarter = 140 or faster.
- 2. Scales Packet: Play All 12 Major Scales. One or Two octaves optional. Tempo is quarter = 140 or faster.
- 3. Bring a prepared piece, preferably in the style of Chopin, Beethoven, Mozart, etc.

Audition Tips

- Yes! You can use music and metronome. Nothing needs to be memorized.
- During the audition process, Mr. Stai is your biggest cheerleader! He wants you to do well.
- What determines your eligibility and whether you make it into the ensemble?
 - Your Musical Ability
 - Work Ethic
 - o Attitude
 - o Openings based on your instrument/overall instrumental balance across the ensemble.
- Auditions will most likely last anywhere from 7-9 minutes, including restarts. Don't restart and stop too much so that you can play more music.
- Don't get too discouraged. Several auditions result in the words "not yet". If hearing "not yet" will send you into a negative tailspin or cause you to "quit band", don't audition! Instead, start working toward the following year's audition.
