

Basic Marching Band & Colorguard Info for New & Returning Members

Member Qualifications:

- Winds & Percussion need to be a student that is currently enrolled in band at Sherwood High School.
 - Colorguard members just need to be currently enrolled as a student at Sherwood High School.
- Grade requirements are as follows:
 - Members must currently be passing and able to maintain grades in all classes. Grades will be checked on a regular basis. Members are not eligible to perform if they do not meet the following requirements:
 - o Minimum GPA of 2.0
 - o No Fs
 - Homeroom assignments completed
- Failure to meet grade requirements leads to missed performances until grade requirements are met (this is a process that can take some time).
- Never previously quit or have been dismissed from the team mid-season.
- Knowledge of commitment, all practices, camp dates, fees and team expectations.
- Have a good attitude, and be ready to learn, perform, play music and have fun!

Weekly Routine:

- Two Full Ensemble afternoon/nights a week during the fall:
 - Tuesdays 3:45-6:45pm
 - Wednesdays 5:30pm-9:00pm
- Most Mondays have Section Rehearsals: Sectional Rehearsals are where Colorguard, Percussion, Winds all rehearse separately.
- Most Fridays are Football Games and/or Rehearsals 3:45pm until finished.
- Most Saturdays are Rehearsals, Fundraisers, Competitions.
- Additional rehearsals are located on our band calendar which is available at www.sherwoodbands.org

Marching Band & Colorguard Camp:

- There are June & August Camp Dates during the summer that are mandatory. See Calendar Handout for Specific Dates/Times for Winds, Percussion, and Colorguard.
- Each day of our August camp equals one week of regular season instruction. If a student misses 2 days of the August camp, they miss two weeks of school.

Football Games:

- Football games will occur 4 times this year. Attendance is mandatory.
- Call time for SMB members is 3:45pm.
- Students will be fed dinner by our band boosters at each game.
- Playoff Games If the varsity SHS team makes playoffs, we will perform as a pep band in the stands only (no halftime show).

Marching Band Competitions:

- These will be all day events (8am-11pm) on Saturdays in September & October. Attendance is mandatory.
- All parents need to sign up for one volunteer shift at a competition during the course of the season. We always need help pulling trailers, camp setup, feeding members, fitting uniforms, and more. It is an expectation for all parents to volunteer in some way to make our season a success.
